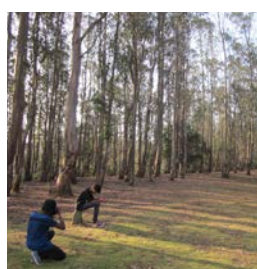


The Lion Inside Outdoor Theatre PWYCE2
